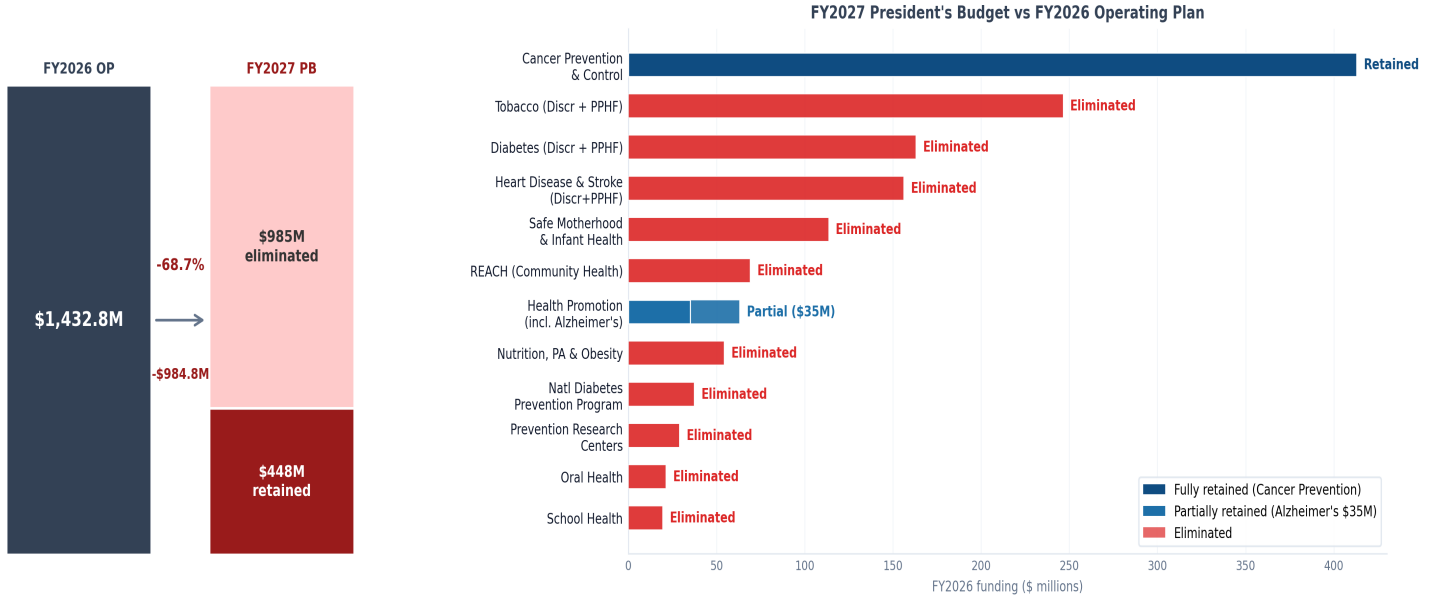

## SUMMARY

The FY2027 President's Budget proposes transferring Chronic Disease Prevention and Health Promotion from CDC to AHA while cutting total funding by \$984.8 million (-68.7%), from \$1,432.8 million to \$448.0 million — the largest absolute reduction of any CDC program in the proposal. Cancer Prevention and Control (\$413.0 million) is the only program fully retained, accounting for 92% of the FY2027 total. The Alzheimer's Program (\$35.0 million, down from \$41.5M) is partially retained under AHA; all other Health Promotion sub-programs are eliminated. Programs proposed for elimination span the full breadth of chronic disease work: Tobacco (\$246.5M), Diabetes — both discretionary and PPHF (\$163.1M), Heart Disease and Stroke (\$156.1M), Safe Motherhood and Infant Health (\$113.5M), REACH (\$69.0M), Nutrition and Physical Activity (\$54.3M), the National Diabetes Prevention Program (\$37.3M), Prevention Research Centers (\$29.0M), and Oral Health (\$21.3M). The entire \$449.0 million PPHF allocation is also eliminated, cutting funding across Tobacco, Diabetes, and Heart Disease programs that relied heavily on the Prevention Fund. Three stand-alone PPHF programs are fully eliminated: Million Hearts (\$5.0M), National Early Child Care Collaboratives (\$5.0M), and Hospitals Promoting Breastfeeding (\$9.75M). Of the \$1,432.8 million FY2026 total, \$983.8 million was discretionary and \$449.0 million was PPHF; under FY2027, all PPHF is eliminated and discretionary is cut by \$535.8 million (-54.5%), with the remaining \$448.0 million entirely discretionary. All retained funding transfers to AHA; no portion of this program remains at CDC under the proposal.
