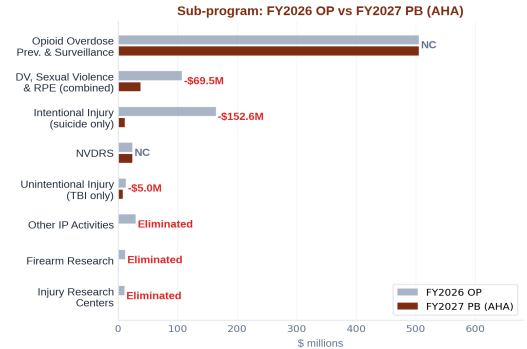
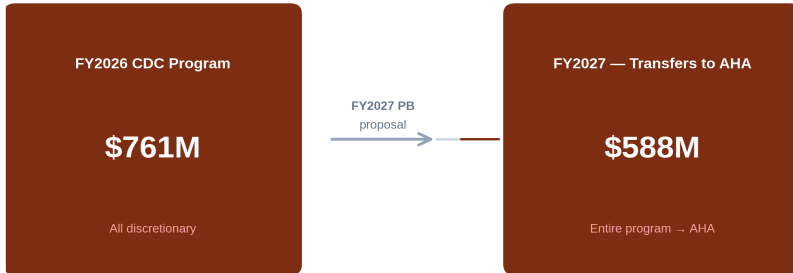

SUMMARY

The FY2027 President's Budget proposes transferring the entire Injury Prevention and Control program from CDC to AHA, reducing total funding by \$173.1 million (-22.7%). Seven sub-programs are eliminated including Firearm Research (\$12.5M), Youth Violence Prevention (\$18.1M), Adverse Childhood Experiences (\$9.0M), Injury Control Research Centers (\$11.0M), Other Injury Prevention Activities (\$30.0M), Elderly Falls (\$3.1M), and Drowning (\$2.0M). Opioid Overdose Prevention (\$505.6M) is preserved unchanged at 86% of the FY2027 total.
