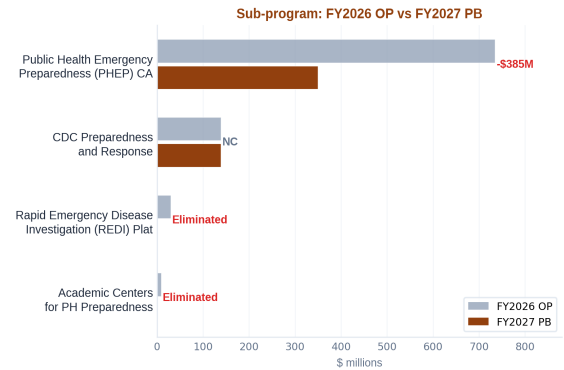
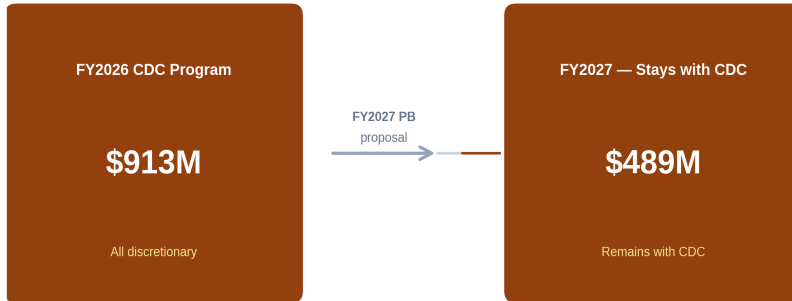

SUMMARY

The FY2027 President's Budget proposes a reduction of \$424.2 million (-46.5%) for Public Health Emergency Preparedness and Response, one of the largest cuts to any CDC program. The program remains with CDC with no proposed agency transfer. The Public Health Emergency Preparedness (PHEP) Cooperative Agreement — the primary vehicle for state and local public health preparedness — is cut by \$385.0 million (-52.4%) to \$350.0 million. CDC Preparedness and Response (\$139.0M) is unchanged. The Rapid Emergency Disease Investigation (REDI) Platform (\$30.0M) and Academic Centers for Public Health Preparedness (\$9.2M) are proposed for elimination.
